



WEST ESSEX BOWMEN "252" INDOOR IMPROVEMENT AWARD

The 252 award is designed to help you practice your shooting at different distances and recognise your achievements. After 6 sighters, you shoot 3 dozen arrows on 80cm, 60cm and 40cm faces at 15yards and again at 20yards, with the aim of scoring 252 or better (alternative scores apply for other bow types). If you achieve the score twice you can claim a badge.

This scheme has been devised by us based on the outdoor 252 award scheme and applies to all archers, irrespective of age, ability or bow type (scores differ by bowtype).

The Rules:

- Six sighters to be followed immediately by three dozen scored arrows.
- 5-zone scoring (Gold = 9, Red = 7, Blue = 5, Black = 3, White = 1), starting at 15yards 80cm face and finishing at 20yards 40cm face.
- Badges must be claimed in sequence (i.e 80cm 15yds, 60cm 15yds, 40cm 15yds, 80cm 20yds, 60cm 20yds and lastly 40cm 20yds)
- Scores need to be achieved **twice** to qualify for the award.
- **Qualifying scores for a given distance can be shot on the same day**
- To make an award claim, **2 signed and witnessed** score sheets need to be submitted to the club's Records Officer.

- The awards are as follows:
